Web Neutering is major surgery requiring general anesthesia Studies show that about 20% of neuter procedures have at least one complication, such as a bad reaction to the anesthesia, infection, abscess, etc Fortunately, most complications are minor Less than 5% are serious, and the death rate is less than 1%
